





A showing of Dudley's paintings to Indiana legislators in 1923 gave rise to the idea of establishing the Indiana Dunes State Park. Dudley's studio cottage was on land owned by the State of Indiana. To remain, Dudley agreed to donate one painting a year to the state. In this way, he was able to remain in Cottage 108 until 1952. In 1967, ten years after his death, his wife sold 53 paintings to the State of Indiana.
