31st Elkhart Juried Regional *The Largest Awards Show in the State!* \$29,100 *in Awards in 2009*

The 31st Elkhart Juried Regional exhibition opens on Friday, November 6, and will continue through Sunday, January 3, 2010. This year the total awards to be given to artists will be **\$29,100**, with the **\$1,200** Best of Show Award donated in memory of the late **Alice Skoglund**. For the eigth year, a special Memorial Purchase Award will be given in honor of **Mary Feddersen** for Photography sponsored by Ron & Connie Minzey and Stuart & Paula Barb of Elkhart.

Selected Works from the Permanent Collection

A special opportunity to see new acquisitions and other art from nearly 2700 works acquired over the past 30 years.

Since the publication of the first *Catalogue of the Permanent Collection* in 2004 the Midwest Museum has received **over 800 new works.** This raises the number of total works to nearly 2,700 pieces. Significant holdings of 20th Century works on paper, paintings, and graphics have resulted. Some works will be featured in a forthcoming exhibit, "Selected Works from the

Permanent Collection", in January and February, 2010.



Recently 30 works by important American artists

were donated by Dr. Steven Conant of Indianapolis. Dr. Conant, an Elkhart native, has given **466** works of art to the Midwest Museum since 1993. Representative examples by **Lee Bontecou**, **Agnes Denes, Fritz Scholder, Arthur Wesley Dow,** and **Karl Wirsum** are included in this recent gift. A significant amount of work by **Gabor Peterdi**, the Dean of American printmakers, has been donated by Dr. Conant. This group of over 60 works will be formed into a traveling exhibit offered by the museum in the future.

Many thanks goes to Dr. Steven Conant for his continued support and interest in shaping the collection of the Midwest Museum of American Art.

Special Museum Funds

The Midwest Museum of American Art would like to heighten our public's awareness of the various "Funds" to which they can donate throughout the year.

The **Eva Cole Educational Fund** was established in 1990 by a former 1939 EHS graduate, Christiana Smith Graham. Through this fund the Midwest Museum brings speakers and programs to Elkhart to educate and enrich our knowledge of America's great art heritage. The **Acquisition Fund** was started in 1997 by Eleanor Grieb and Robert Fancil. This fund allows the museum to purchase artworks both from new and emerging artists as well as well known artists. The **Library Fund** was started in 2005 by former residents, John and Janet Von der Heide. Recognizing the need to upgrade and expand the museum's library, the Von der Heides started this ongoing fund as a reminder of the importance research plays in identifying art and artists.

Our current temporary project is the **Roof Fund**. The need to replace the 26-year old, Bay Systems polyurethane insulated roof, has necessitated the beginning of this fund. The local Quester chapters— Christiana #765, LaSalle-Rousseau #441, Michiana Voyagers #1642, plus the Indiana State Questers and International Questers organizations along with the local A-Z study group— have embraced this project and are actively seeking grant funding for MMAA.

We cordially invite you to contribute to any of these funds. Your donation is 100% tax deductible and will be acknowledged in our newsletter and a notice is sent to the families of those memorialized.

The Elkhart Juried Regional has placed over \$350,000 in the hands of Michiana artists over the past 30 years. Only one purchase award was available in 1979-1980. Today (2009) there are 36 Purchase Awards totalling \$26,400. With the Alice Skoglund Memorial BEST of SHOW at \$1,200 and several Merit Awards, the total prize monies come to \$29,100.
